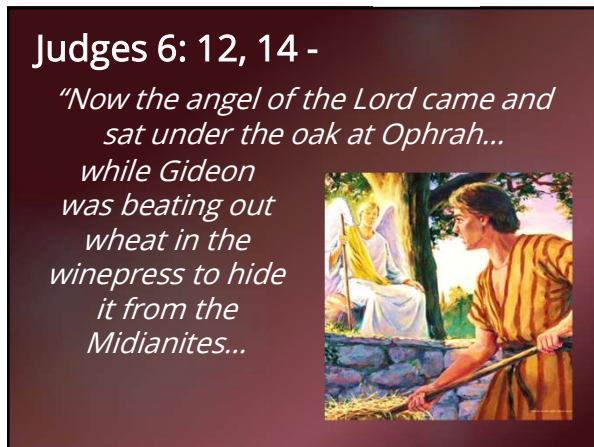

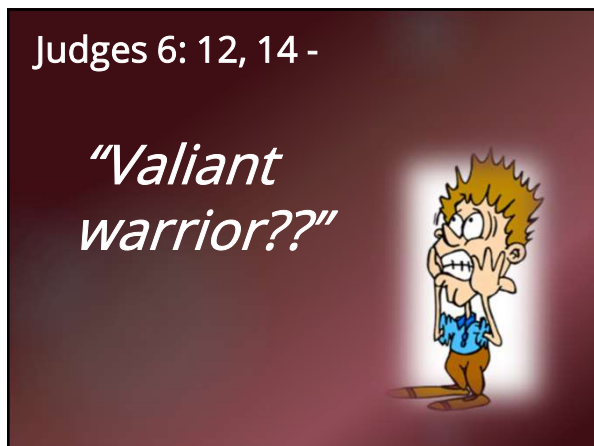

- "geber" – physically strong, valiant, powerful, warrior, champion (from his strength).
