When he had gone a little farther, he saw James son of Zebedee and his brother John in a boat, preparing their nets. Without delay he called them, and they left their father Zebedee in the boat with the hired men and followed him...




In the Garden of Eden, the first Adam...

- Desires, purposes & will – accomplished!

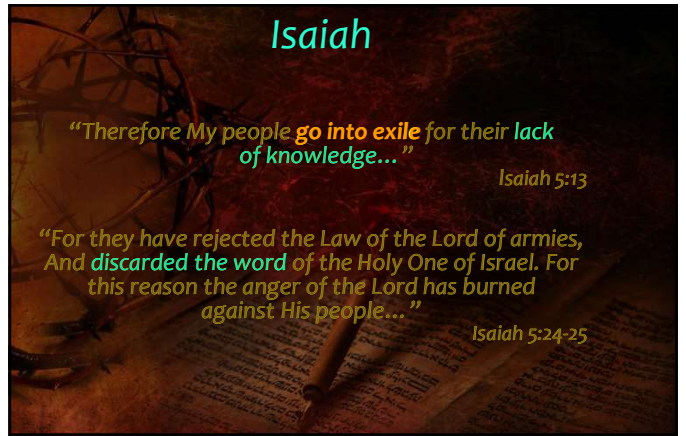
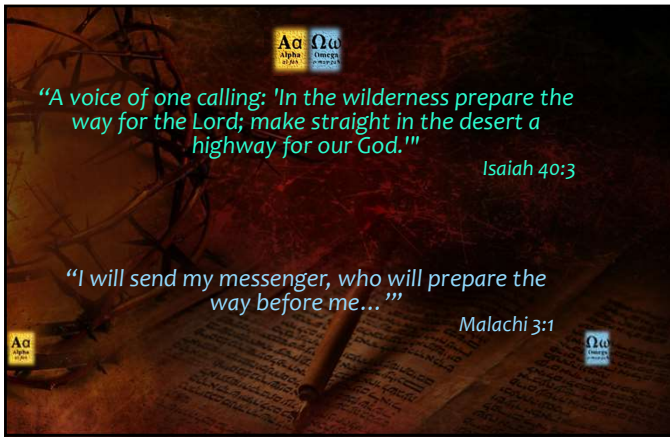
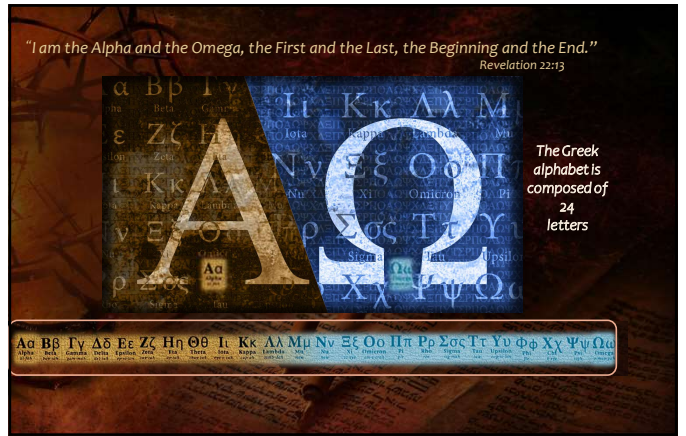
The realm & period in which God’s sovereign kingdom of God are fully established & unchallenged!



They went to Capernaum, and when the Sabbath came...

Capernaum ("Village Of Consolation") was a fishing town along the sea of Galilee. It became Jesus' home town after the death of John the Baptist and His rejection at Nazareth.

And leaving Nazareth, he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zebulun and Naphtali ...

In shutting the mouths of demons, He silences their voice but reveals His authority!
