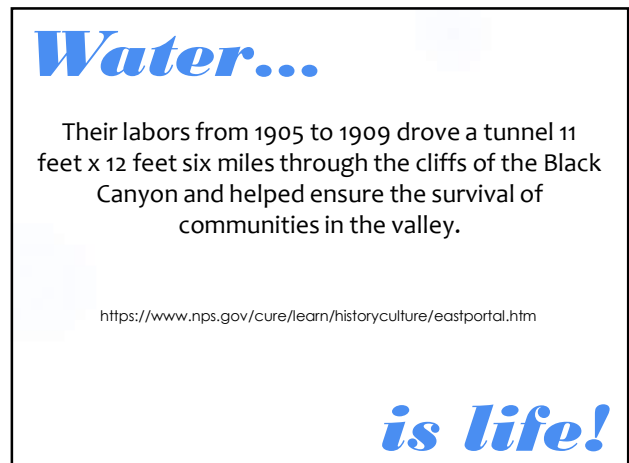
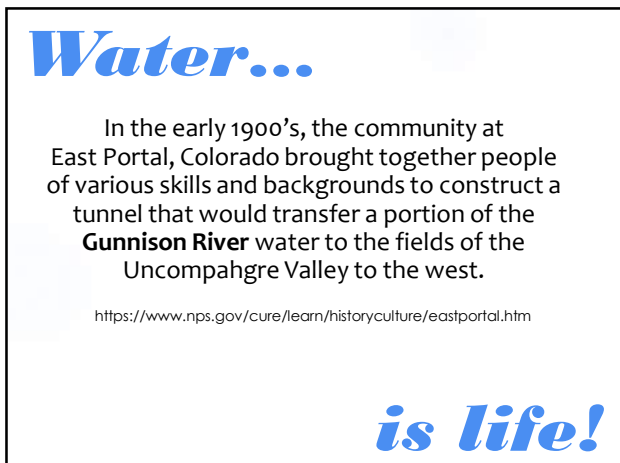
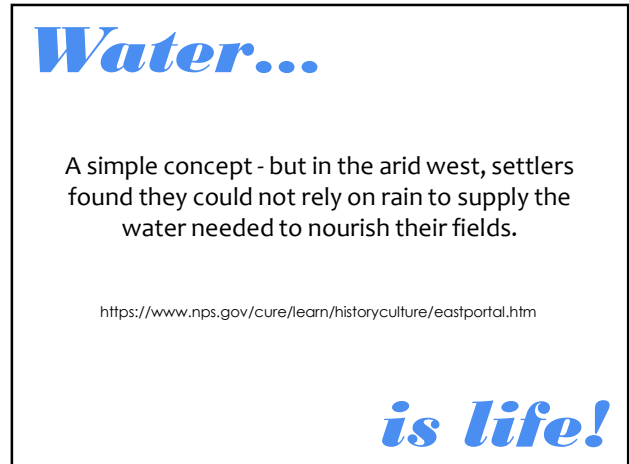

It is Colorado's 2nd largest river by volume...



...it courses west from the Continental Divide and flows for 180 miles before joining the Colorado River at the town of Grand Junction



The confluence nearly doubles the Colorado River's volume.



The **Black Canyon of the Gunnison National Park** exposes you to some of the steepest cliffs, oldest rock, and craggiest spires in North America.



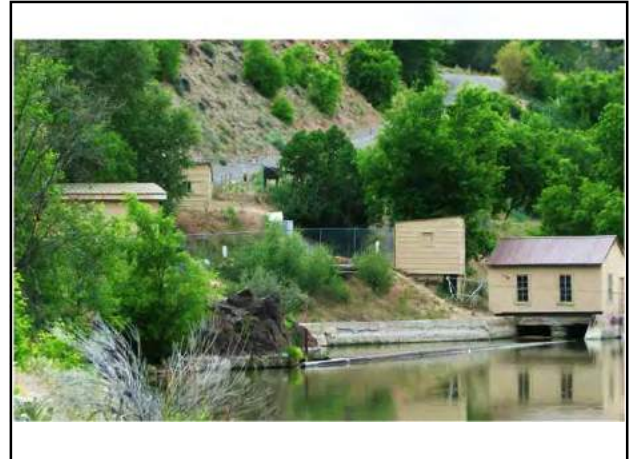
This canyon earned its name from the shadows that often obscure its depths. At its narrowest point, it's just 40 feet wide at the river.

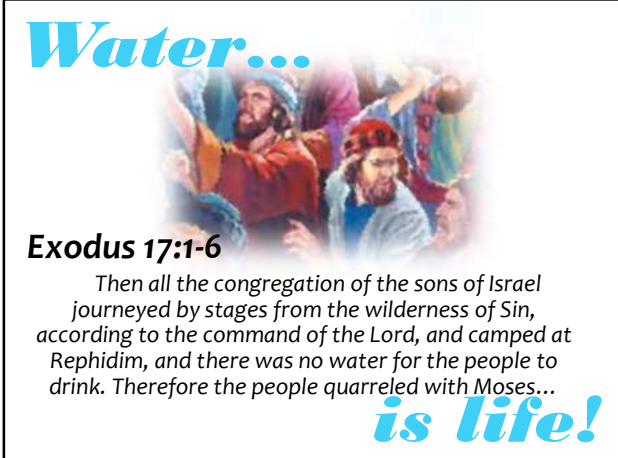
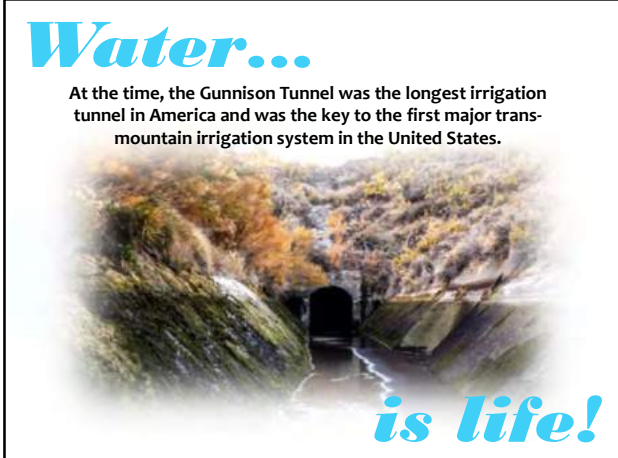


Because of how narrow it is, some parts of the canyon only receive about a half hour of daylight per day. The deepest part of the canyon is 2,722 feet.



**Gunnison Diversion Dam** - Unseen but beneath this dam is an irrigation tunnel that upon its complete in 1909 was the longest irrigation tunnel in the world and was an engineering marvel. The 5.8-mile tunnel cut right through the sheer cliffs of the famed Black Canyon, taking water from the Gunnison River and funneling it to the semiarid Uncompahgre Valley to the west.

2 Chronicles 32 — New International Version

**Sennacherib Threatens Jerusalem**

**32** After all that Hezekiah had so faithfully done, Sennacherib king of Assyria came and invaded Judah. He laid siege to the fortified cities, thinking to conquer them for himself. <sup>2</sup> When Hezekiah saw that Sennacherib had come and that he intended to wage war against Jerusalem, <sup>3</sup> he consulted with his officials and military staff about blocking off the water from the springs outside the city, and they helped him. <sup>4</sup> They gathered a large group of people who blocked all the springs and the stream that flowed through the land. "Why should the kings<sup>al</sup> of Assyria come and find plenty of water?" they said. <sup>5</sup> Then he worked hard repairing all the broken sections of the wall and building towers on it. He built another wall outside that one and reinforced the terraces<sup>al</sup> of the City of David. He also made large numbers of weapons and shields.

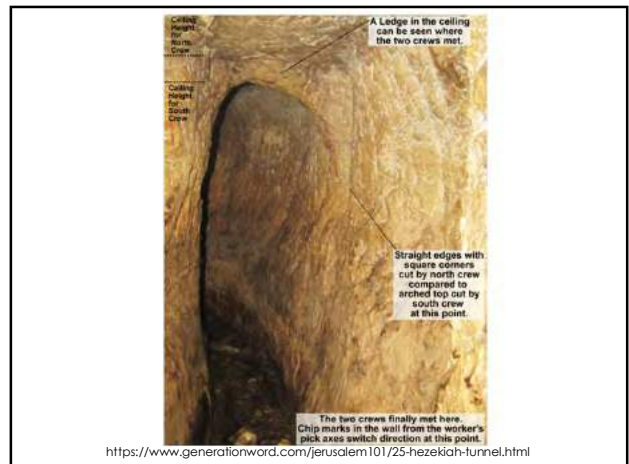
